Can you help us to help carers?

Family Fund is calling on health and social care professionals to make referrals to the Worcestershire Carer Support programme by 4 May 2025. The programme provides a cash grant of £420 to carers of disabled or seriously ill adult relatives living in their household. The grant can be used for items or services that make caring easier, or that allow the carer to take a break or engage in activities to support their own health and well-being.

Who is eligible?

To be eligible for the programme:

- The carer must be aged 25+ and providing full-time care (35 hours or more) for a disabled or seriously ill adult relative (eg a spouse or family member aged 25+) living in the same household.
- The carer and their relative must live in one of the Worcestershire postcode areas covered by the programme (you can use the postcode checker on www.familyfund.org.uk/wcsp-referrer).
- This programme is aimed at carers on a low income, so they must be in receipt of at least one of the following:
- Carers Allowance, Universal Credit or Pension Credit (Guarantee or Savings Credit).
- The person who is being cared for must meet all of the following criteria:
- They must have a life-limiting, permanent physical disability, learning disability or serious illness
- They must require a high-level of personal support with day-to-day activities such as eating, washing, dressing, moving or toileting
- They must be receiving a significant level of medical support or therapeutic treatment.

Only one referral can be made per household.


